

Did you know?*

- Approximately 16,000 individuals are released from Tennessee prisons and jails each year.
- When released from prison in Tennessee, men are only provided with one change of clothing, up to \$75, and a one-way bus pass. Without a support system or job, this typically results in homelessness or recidivism.
- More than half of those released from prison in Tennessee will reoffend within 3 years.
- Over 70% of ex-offenders have dealt with substance abuse issues in their lifetime.

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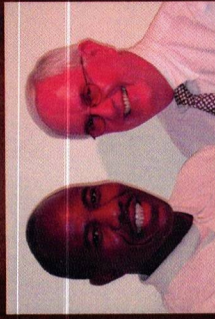

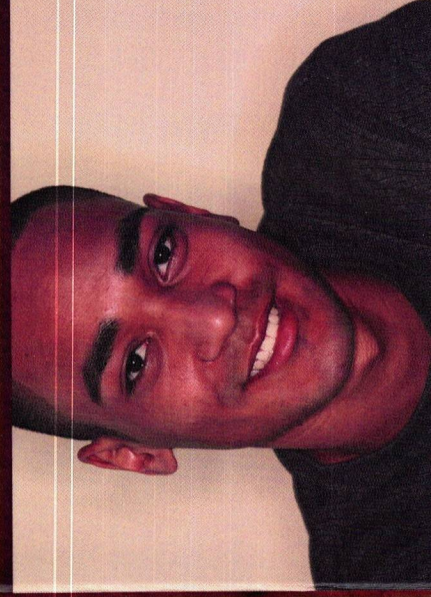
with the personal and professional skills necessary to achieve self-sufficiency as productive, law-abiding members of society.

Programs and Services:

Residential Aftercare Program

- Professional development classes in Job Readiness, Job Retention, and Financial Literacy
